On 3 and 4 August LI President, Frits Bolkestein MP visited  
Buenos Aires at  
the start of his Latin American visit, with a view to  
improving relations  
with the Union Civica Radical (UCR). The visit came at a  
politically  
important moment, as the UCR has just announced an electoral  
coalition with  
the progressive FREPASO.

Mr Bolkestein met among others with Fernando de la Rúa, Mayor  
of Buenos  
Aires, and with Rodolfo Terragno, President of the UCR. Mr  
Terragno  
expressed the need for closer cooperation between UCR and LI.  
UCR members  
will attend the forthcoming LI Congress in Oxford in November.

>From Buenos Aires the delegation went on to visit the Partido  
Liberal

Radical Autentico (PLRA) in Paraguay, in particular the capital Asuncion (which has a Liberal mayor, Martin Burt) and the provinces Departamento Central (Liberal governor Luis Alberto Wagner) and Departamento de la Cordillera (Liberal governor Francisco Rivas) and for talks with the PLRA leader Dr Domingo Laino. The PLRA invited Liberal International to hold their Spring 1999 Congress in Paraguay.

We have the pleasure to inform you that the Radical Democratic Party with Chairman Dr. Boyadjiev is registered as Free Radical Democratic Party with the same Chairman, at the same address and a new Executive Committee. The official announcement of the registration appeared in The Official Gazette # 61 of August 01, 1997. We are now in the process of negotiations with the Liberal Union "New Choice", the Movement for Rights and Freedom and Dr. Jelev as Patron of the LI. The next (and we hope the final) meeting is scheduled for August 8th. The purpose is to organise a Liberal Group in Bulgaria which shall apply for membership in the LI and besides shall make joint efforts in the current political situation in this country. So far the prospects are good, let us hope for a good final stage of the negotiations in the name of the organised liberalism in Bulgaria.
